Nipples in Social Media

Social Media sites have taken their stand in the nip-debate.

- Instagram's policy on nudity allows for male nipples to be shown, but not female.
- Facebook- under "community standards" states that it restricts female breasts if they include the nipple, with the exception of actively breast-feeding women and post-mastectomy scars.

Question: What is the legal penalty and fine for a woman walking topless on the streets of New York City?
